

Commercial Applicator/Farmer Recordkeeping Agreement

A commercial pesticide applicator may hold RUP application records on behalf of a customer if an informal agreement signed by both parties is on file at the business office. It is not a formal contract. The agreement, once signed by both parties, may be kept indefinitely. RUP application records must be kept for a minimum of three years from the date of the pesticide application.

This form may be used as an informal recordkeeping agreement. The agreement must be made available to a Nebraska Department of Agriculture pesticide inspector upon request.
