

## **WPS Hazard Communication Record**

If, within the last 30 days on the establishment: **a)** a pesticide product has been used; or **b)** a restricted-entry interval (REI) for a pesticide has been in effect; the following pesticide application and hazard information must be displayed<sup>1</sup>, retained<sup>2</sup>, and made accessible<sup>3</sup> to workers and handlers who are on the establishment.

<sup>1</sup> This information must be displayed (within 24 hours of the end of an application) at a place on the establishment where workers and handlers are likely to pass by or congregate, and where it can be readily seen and read. It must remain legible at all times.

<sup>2</sup> The agricultural employer must retain this information for two years on the establishment after an applicable REI expires.

<sup>3</sup> Workers and handlers must be allowed access to the location of the information at all times during normal work hours.

<sup>4</sup> The pesticide product's Safety Data Sheet (SDS) must be displayed<sup>1</sup> in addition to the information on this sheet.
